



Guidelines for ISQua Speakers – Lightning Talks

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- **Registration.** Presenters must be registered for the conference by **Wednesday 3rd July 2019** in order to present and have their abstract published in the final programme. Click [HERE](#) to register now.
- **For a 10-minute Lightning Talk presentation we recommend 7 minutes of presentation and 3 minutes for questions and audience discussion.**
- **You will have to produce an electronic-poster as supporting material. The author will present at their E-poster on a large screen, they will be informed about a dedicated space in another e-mail.**
- **The chairperson of your session will be in contact before the conference to introduce themselves.** Please meet the session chairperson at your session area at least ten (10) minutes prior to the start of your scheduled session
- All presentations must be made in English. The use of an interpreter is not permitted.
- Please ensure there is no material within your presentation which could be seen as marketing a commercial product or Programme.

ELECTRONIC POSTER – SUPPORT FOR LIGHTNING TALK

- Your E-Poster will be available on the ISQua website via an E-poster portal and onsite at a dedicated E-Poster station.
- **End of July**, the submitter of the abstract will be contacted directly with instructions on how to design and upload their e-poster.
